## New Landslide Warning Issued Amid Heavy Rain in Tawang



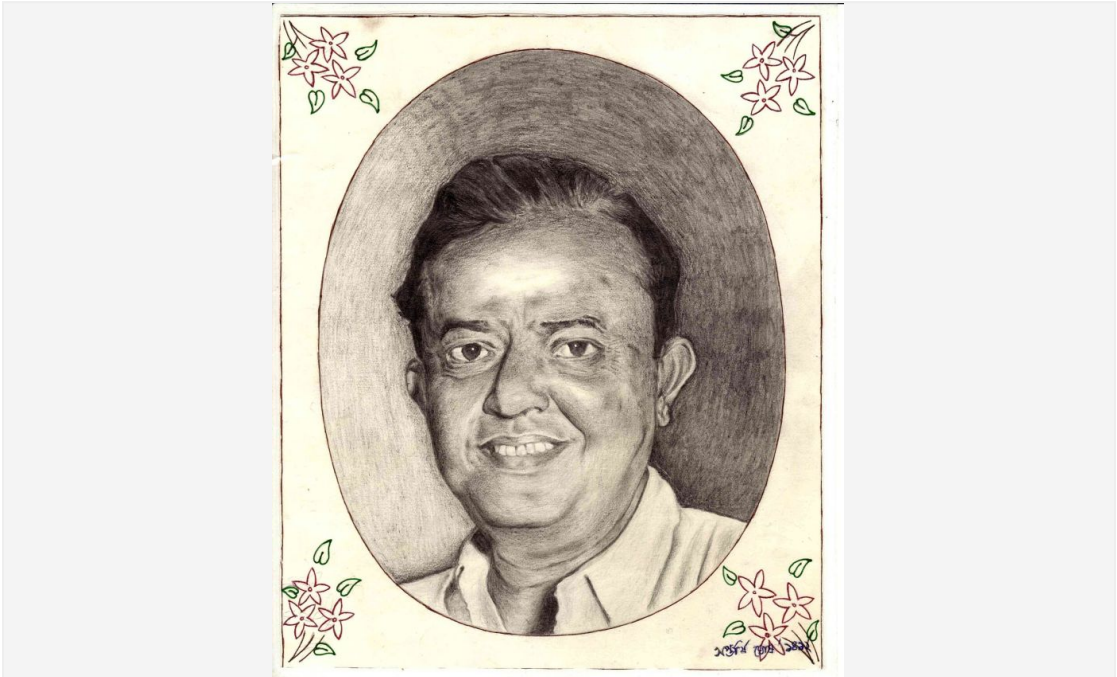

## New 'Ghost Flower' Orchid Discovered in Keyi Panyor, Arunachal

A new orchid species, named the "Ghost Flower," has been discovered in the dense forests of Keyi Panyor, Arunachal. This discovery occurred during a biodiversity survey of the region. Scientists observed the plant's pale, translucent petals, which led to its naming. This finding establishes Arunachal Pradesh as a hub for rare flora and may provide new insights into the ecology of the Eastern Himalayas. Conservation experts have stated that protecting the forests around Keyi Panyor is essential to safeguard this new species and other undiscovered ones. The area requires urgent monitoring due to deforestation and land-use changes.

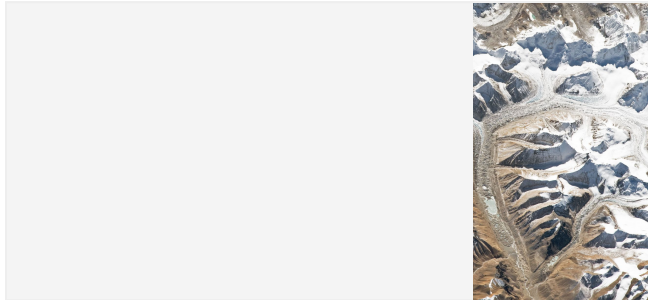
IMD Predicts Heavy Rainfall in Several States

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) issued a bulletin today predicting heavy rainfall in several states over the next 48 hours. Unsafe FCI Warehouse in Doimukh, Arunachal, Threatens Grain Security
