Mizoram Tourism Minister reviews preparations for Anthurium Festival in Riekek



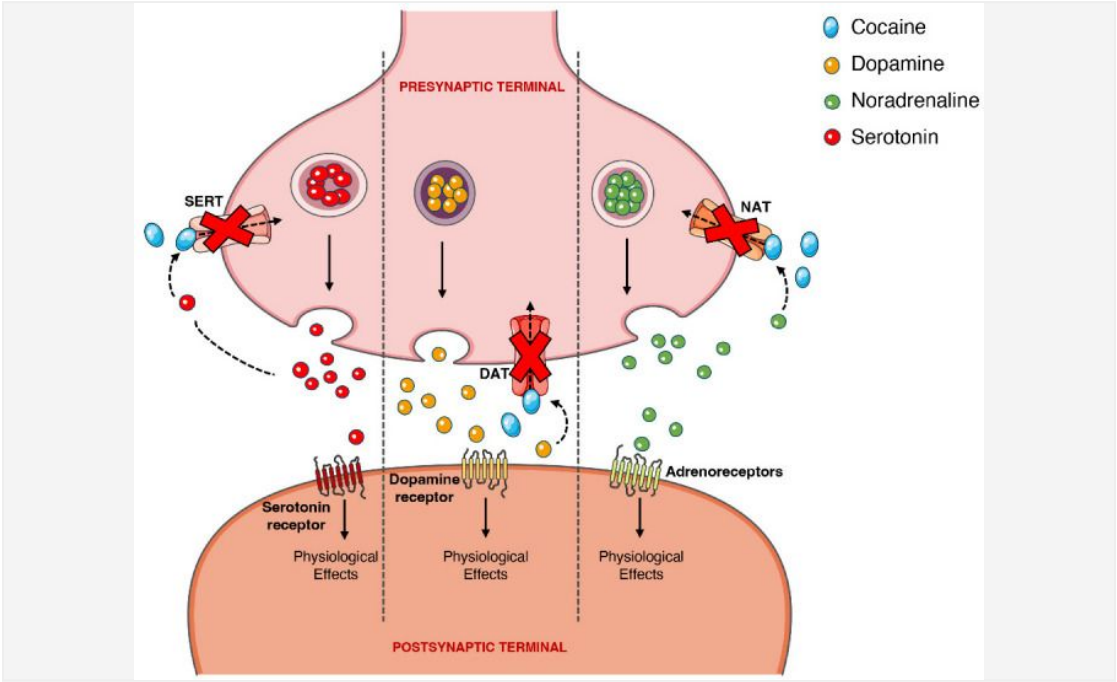

DRI seizes 232 kilograms of methamphetamine in Northeast



The Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) seized 232 kilograms of methamphetamine in a coordinated operati...

The Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) reported that its teams intercepted a shipment of 232 kilograms of methamphetamine in Northeast India. The operation was described as a major crackdown, using multiple checkpoints and intelligence to seize the drugs before distribution. Officials said this seizure is one of the largest

methamphetamine busts in the region. The drugs were intended to be sold wholesale across state borders. DRI will continue investigations to identify the source and the trafficking network, and pledged further action to curb drug smuggling in the Northeast.

Seven auto-rickshaws stolen from Silbhuti, Assam recovered in Mizoram

Mizoram police have recovered seven auto-rickshaws stolen from the Silbhuti area of Assam, according to information obtained by India Today NE from local police sources. The auto-rickshaws were reported stolen from Silbhuti at the beginning of this month, prompting a joint investigation by the police departments of Assam and Mizoram. Officials said the vehicles were found in a village in Mizoram and seized without any confrontation. Police are now further investigating to identify the gang behind the theft and the methods used to transport the vehicles across state borders. 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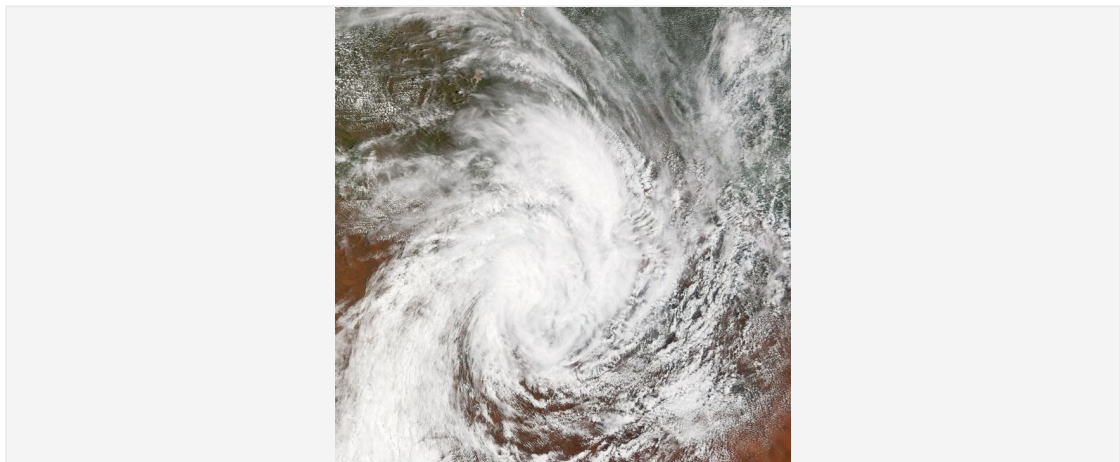
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Widespread Rainfall Expected in Many Regions Next Week

DRI Seizes 232 Kg of Methamphetamine in Northeast India

Mizoram Orders Homestays and Hotels to Report Foreign Guests

The Mizoram Tourism Department has issued a notification directing homestays, hotels, guest houses, and similar establishments to submit information about foreign nationals staying on their premises. This order applies to all such accommodation providers operating in the state. Under the new rule, operators must provide guests' passport details, nationality, date of arrival, and expected date of departure to the concerned district authorities. This information is to be shared within the stipulated timeframe specified in the notification. Officials stated that the move aims to improve security, monitor tourist movement, and ensure compliance...

Aizawl Launches Four-Category Waste Segregation System

On September 15, 2024, the Aizawl Municipal Corporation launched a four-category waste segregation system. Under this scheme, waste has been divided into organic, recyclable, hazardous, and general categories, with separate collection bins provided for each. This initiative is expected to reduce landfill usage by 30% and increase recycling rates. Residents will be provided with separate bins and encouraged to segregate waste at the source. The city administration will monitor the program's impact over the next year.

Myanmar National Detained in Mizoram with 5.5 Kg of Meth Tablets
